(57) **CLAIM**

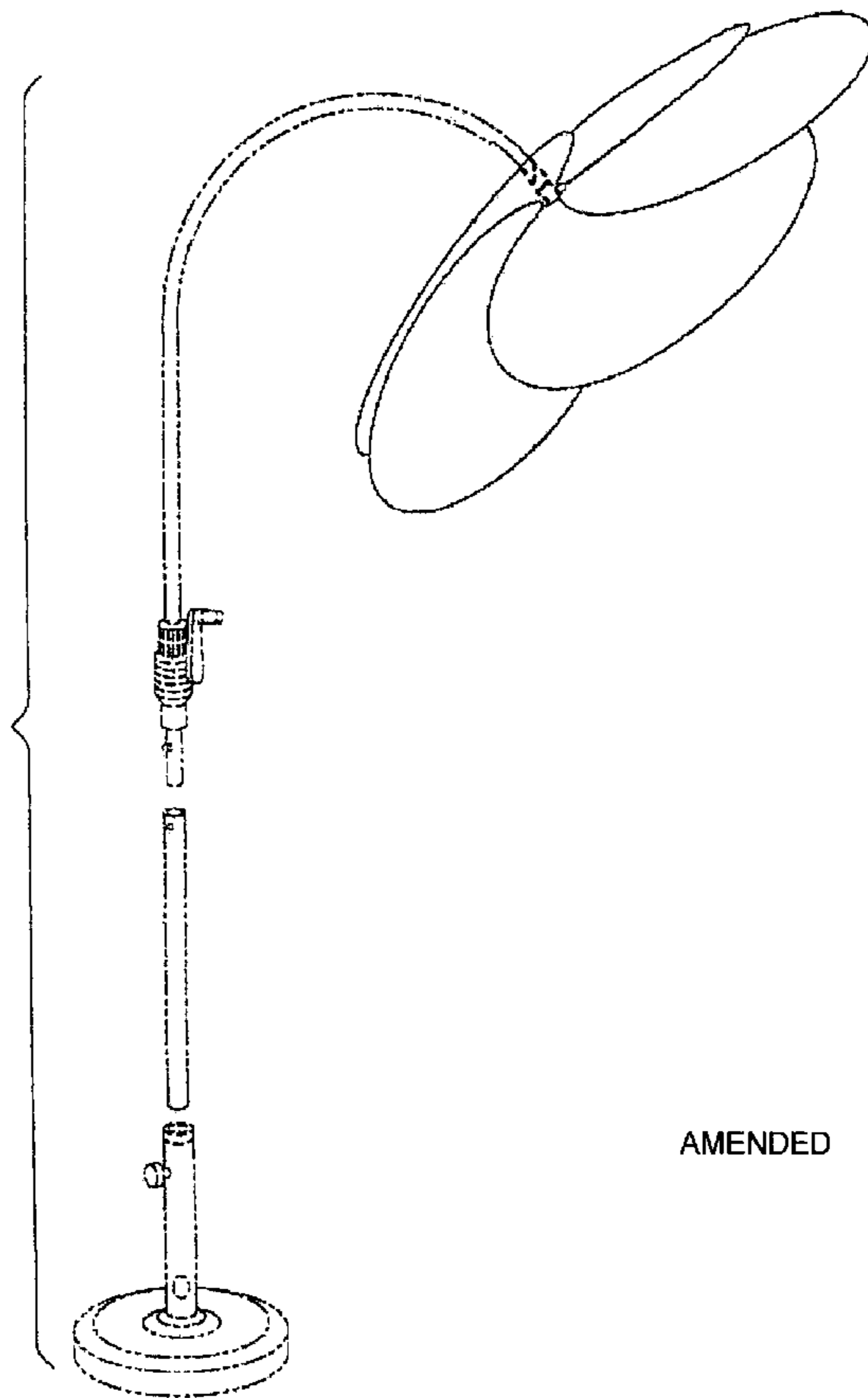
The ornamental design for [an umbrella] *a parasol* [for patio or beach use], as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side perspective view of [an umbrella] *a parasol* [for patio or beach use] showing my new design in condition of use with a curved pole and stand; and, FIG. 2 is a front perspective view thereof shown in condition of use with an ornamental endcap, partial pole and crankshaft. 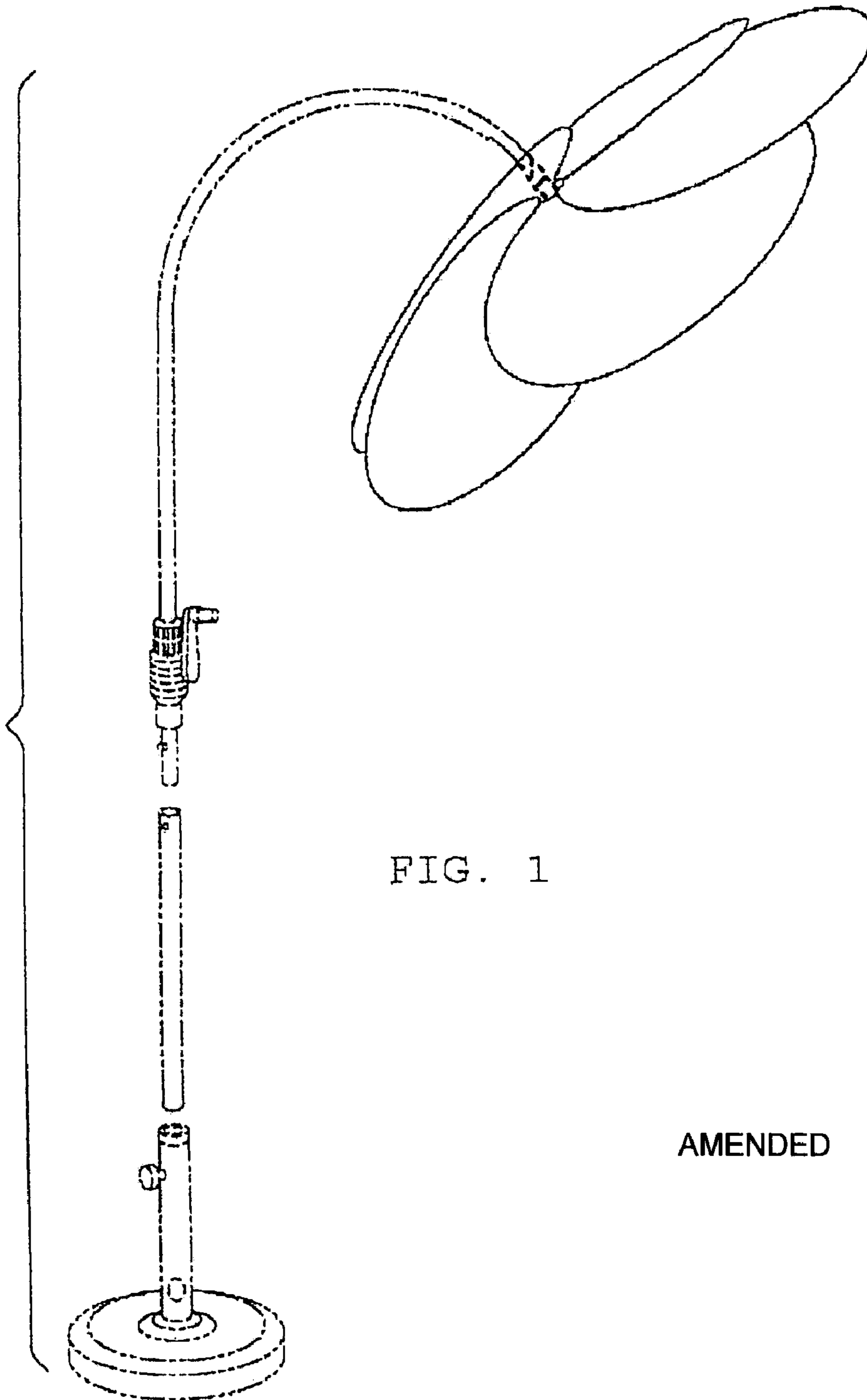

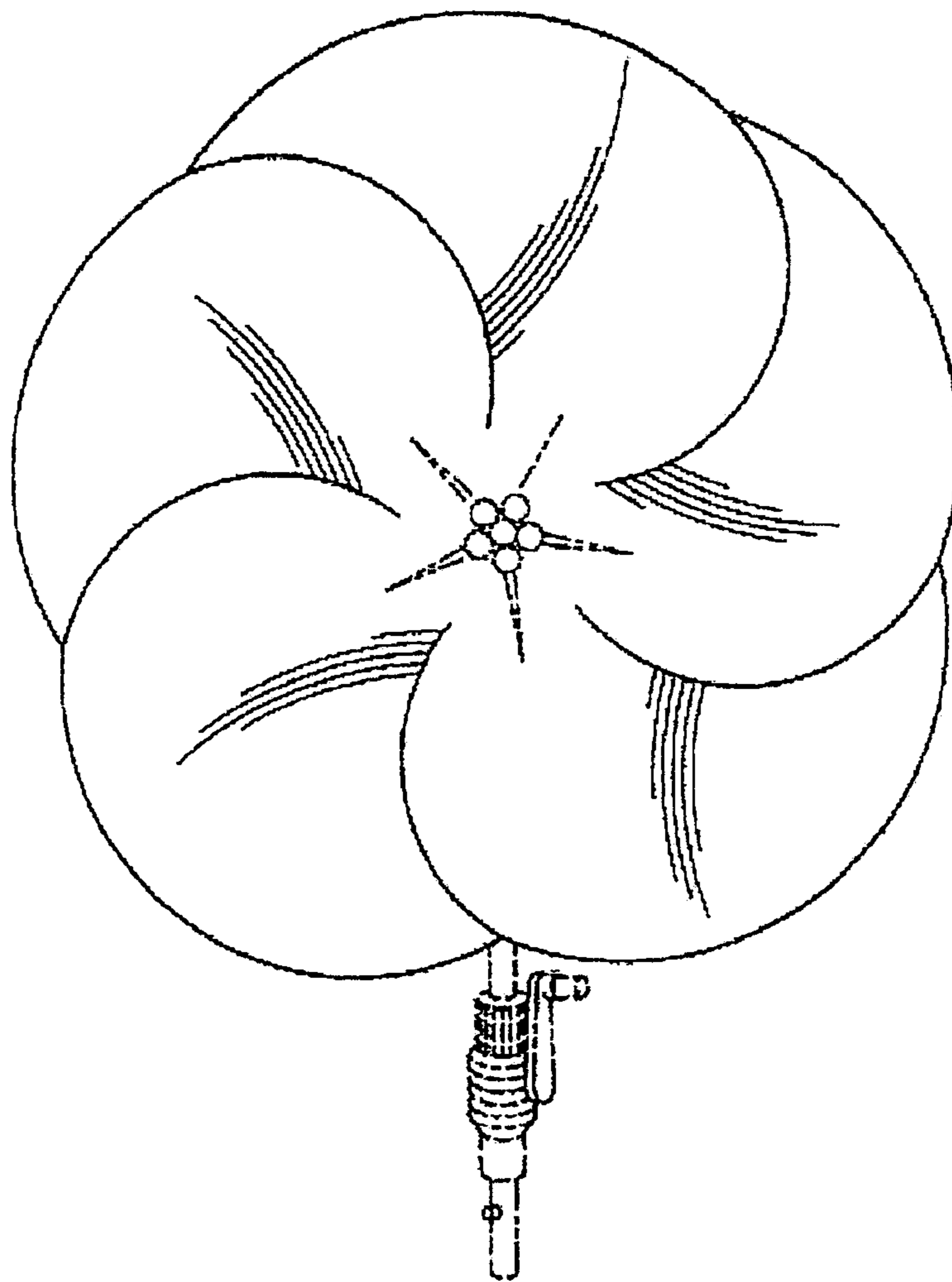
