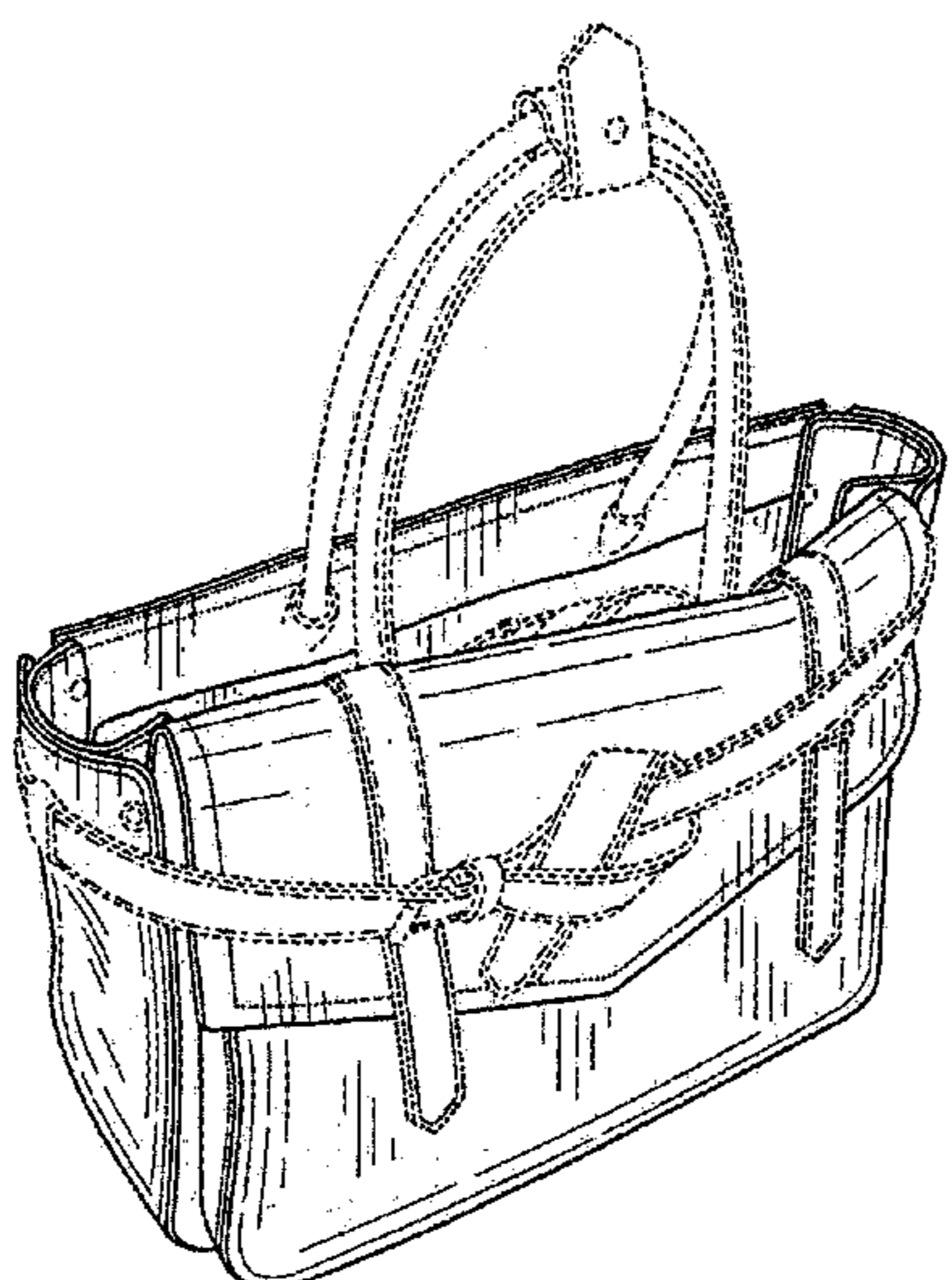
[FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the claimed design.]

The broken line showing of the handles, grommets, handle clasp, straps, belt, belt holes, belt loops and the hook fastener closure element in FIGS. 8-14 depict portions of the bag in which the design is embodied that are not claimed. In addition, for clarity, the stitching on the unclaimed subject matter is shown in lines of dot-dash-dot-dash. The stitching on the claimed subject matter is shown by dotted lines.

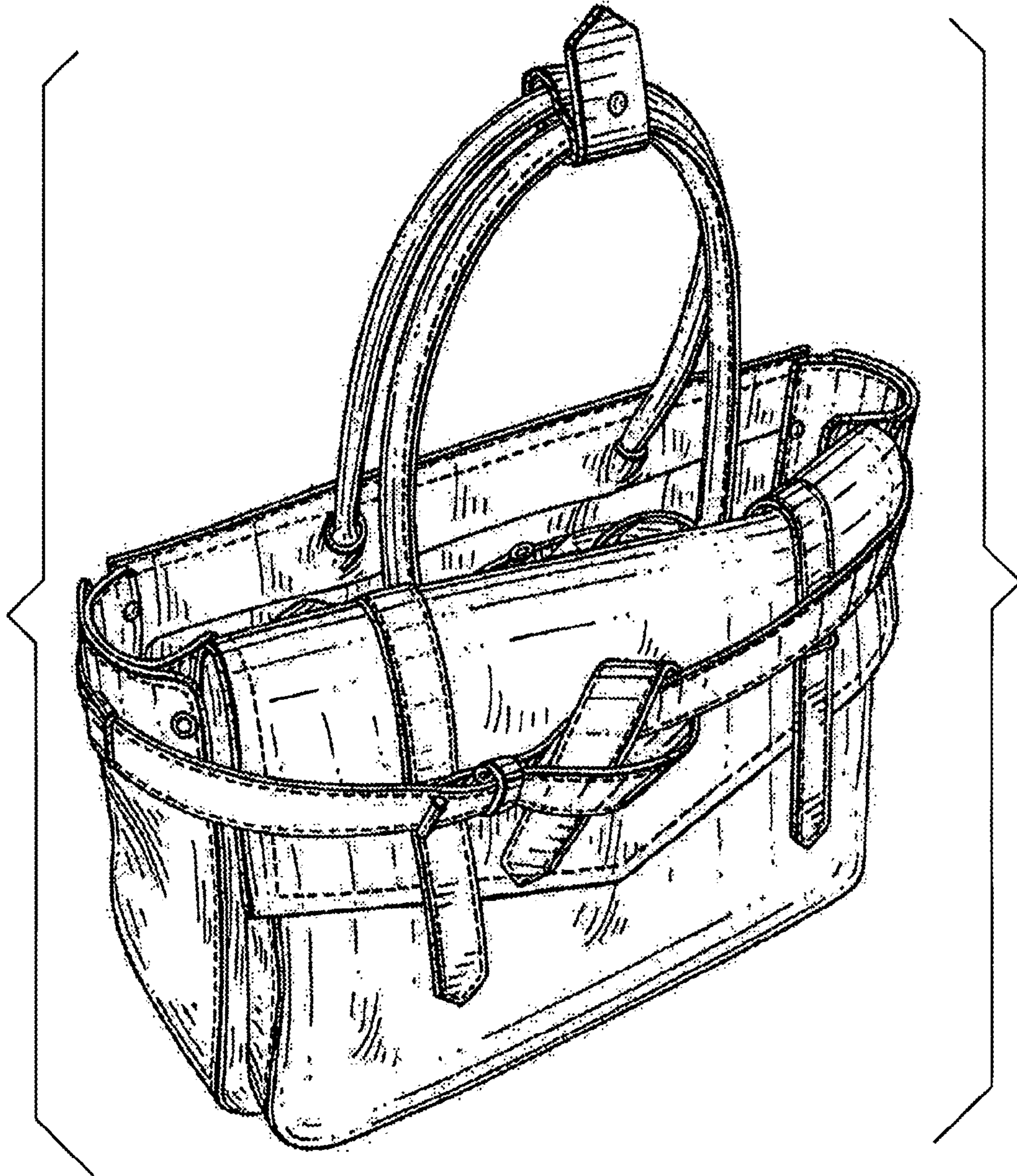

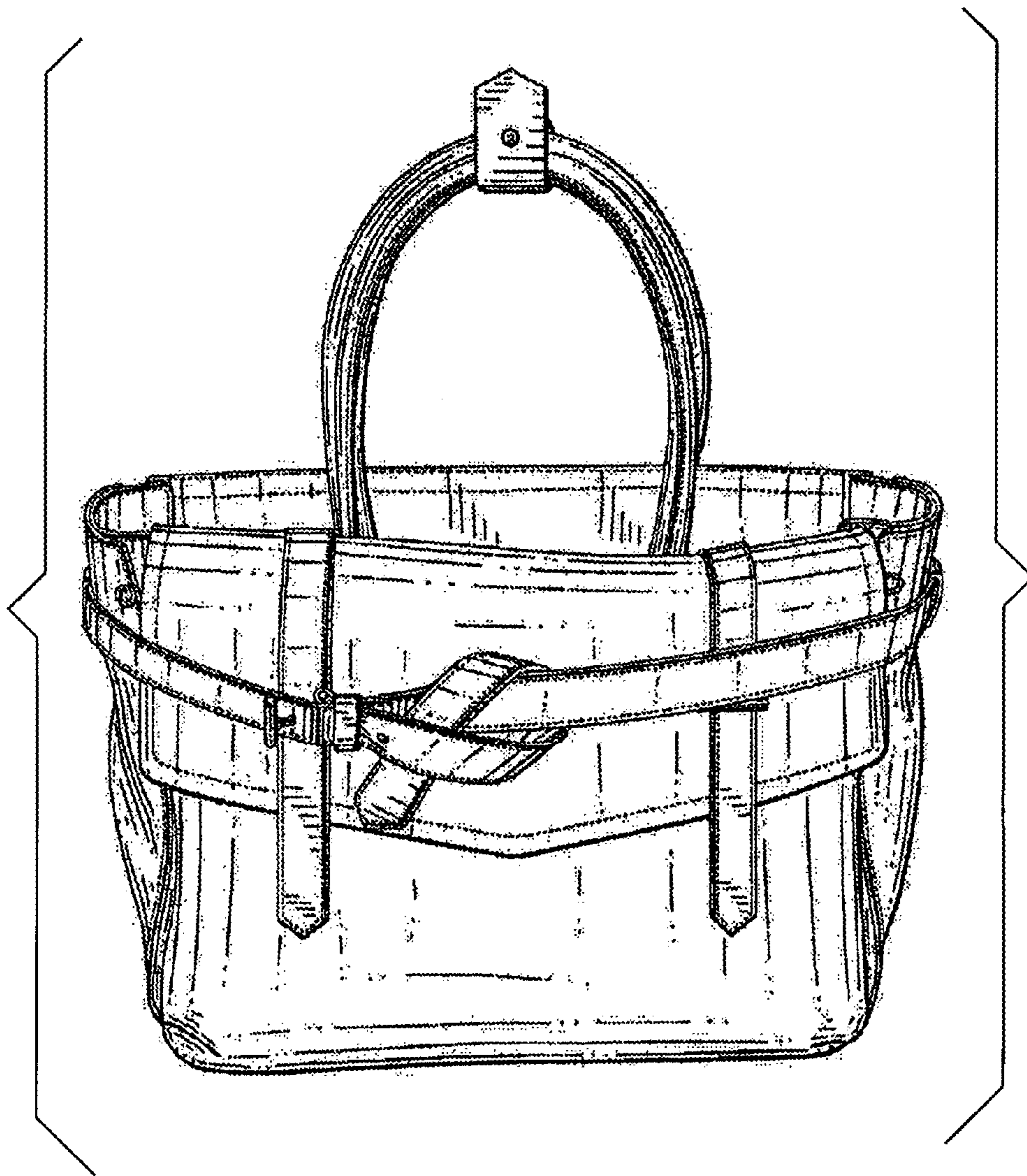

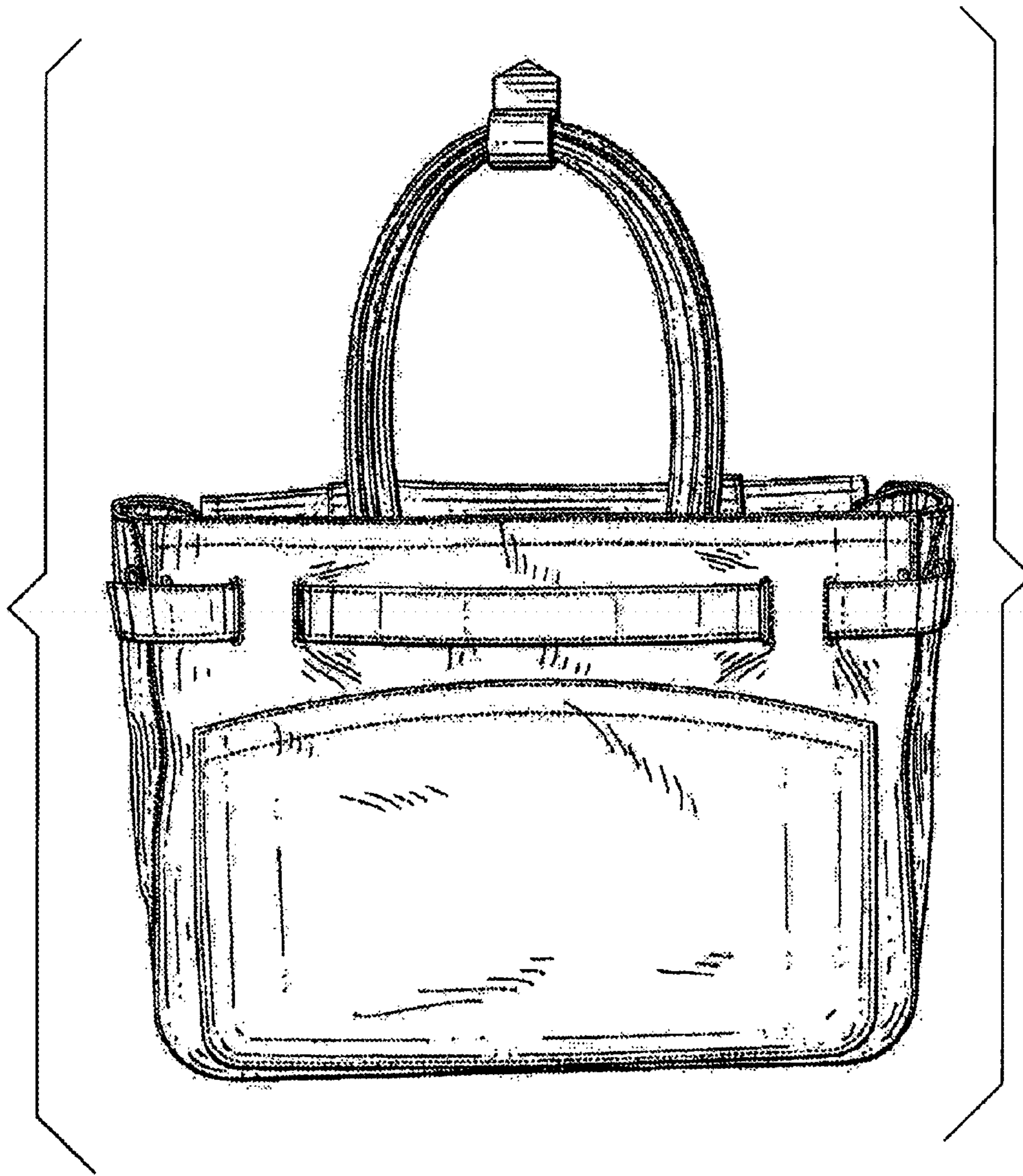

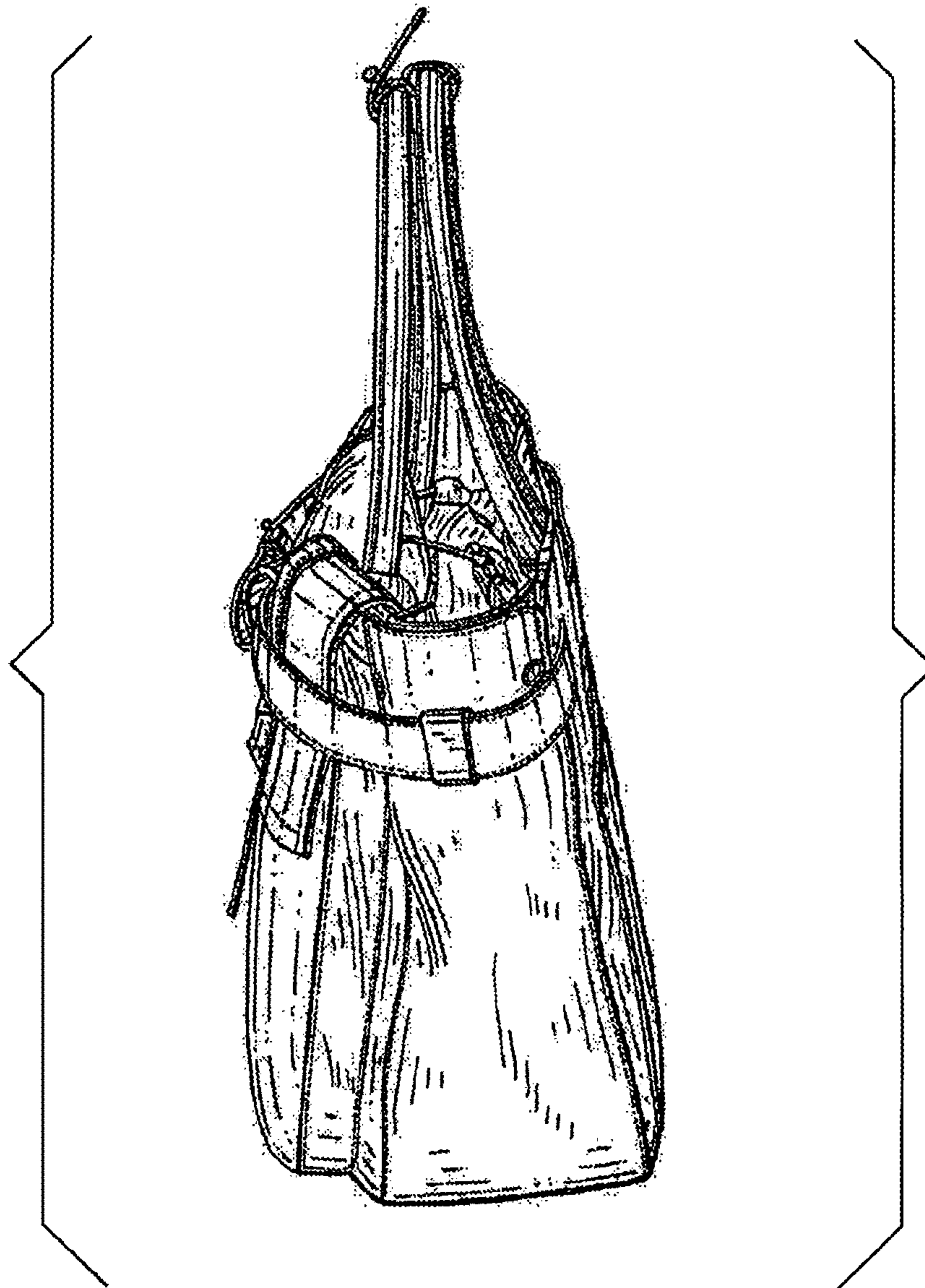

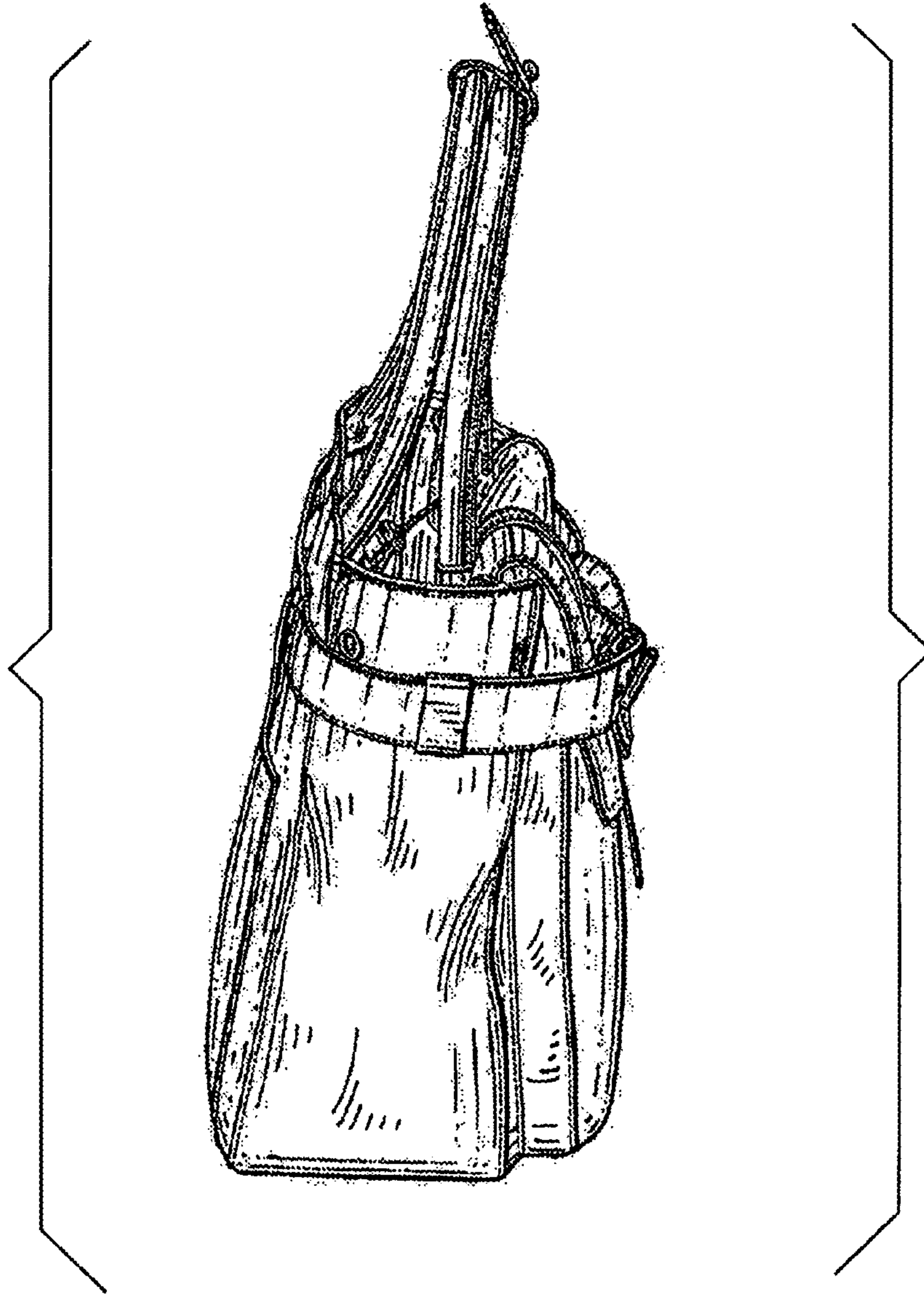

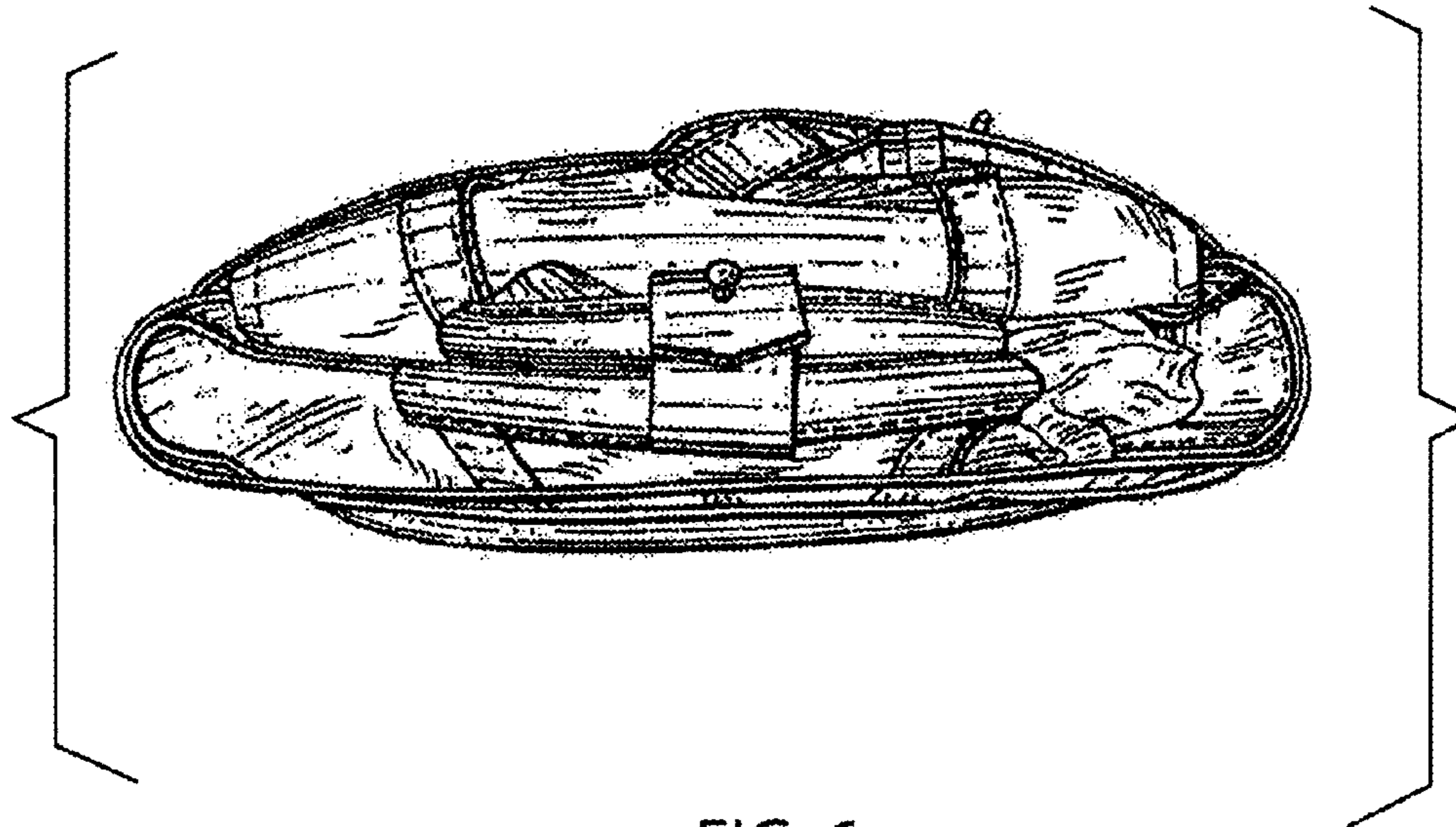

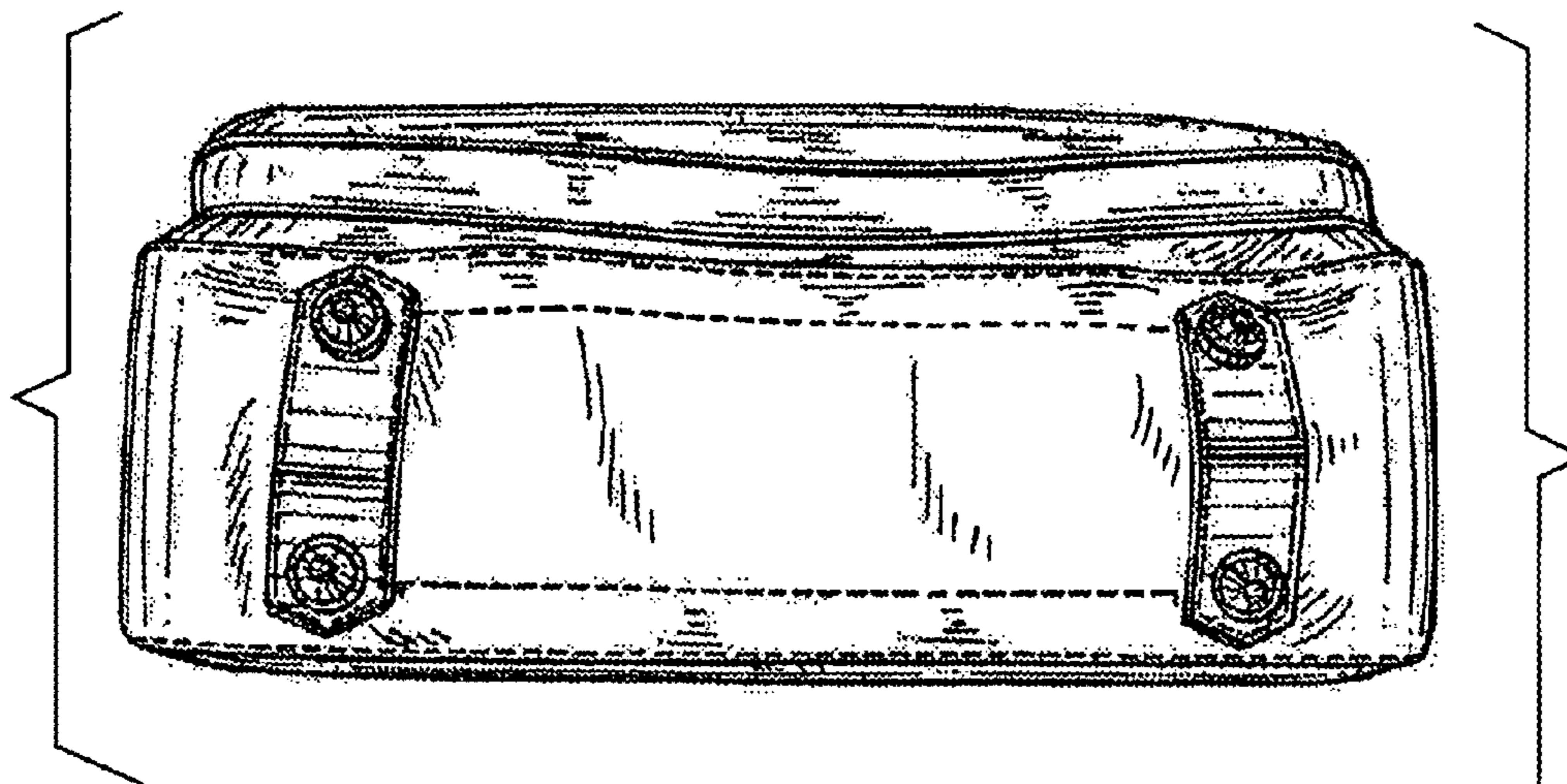

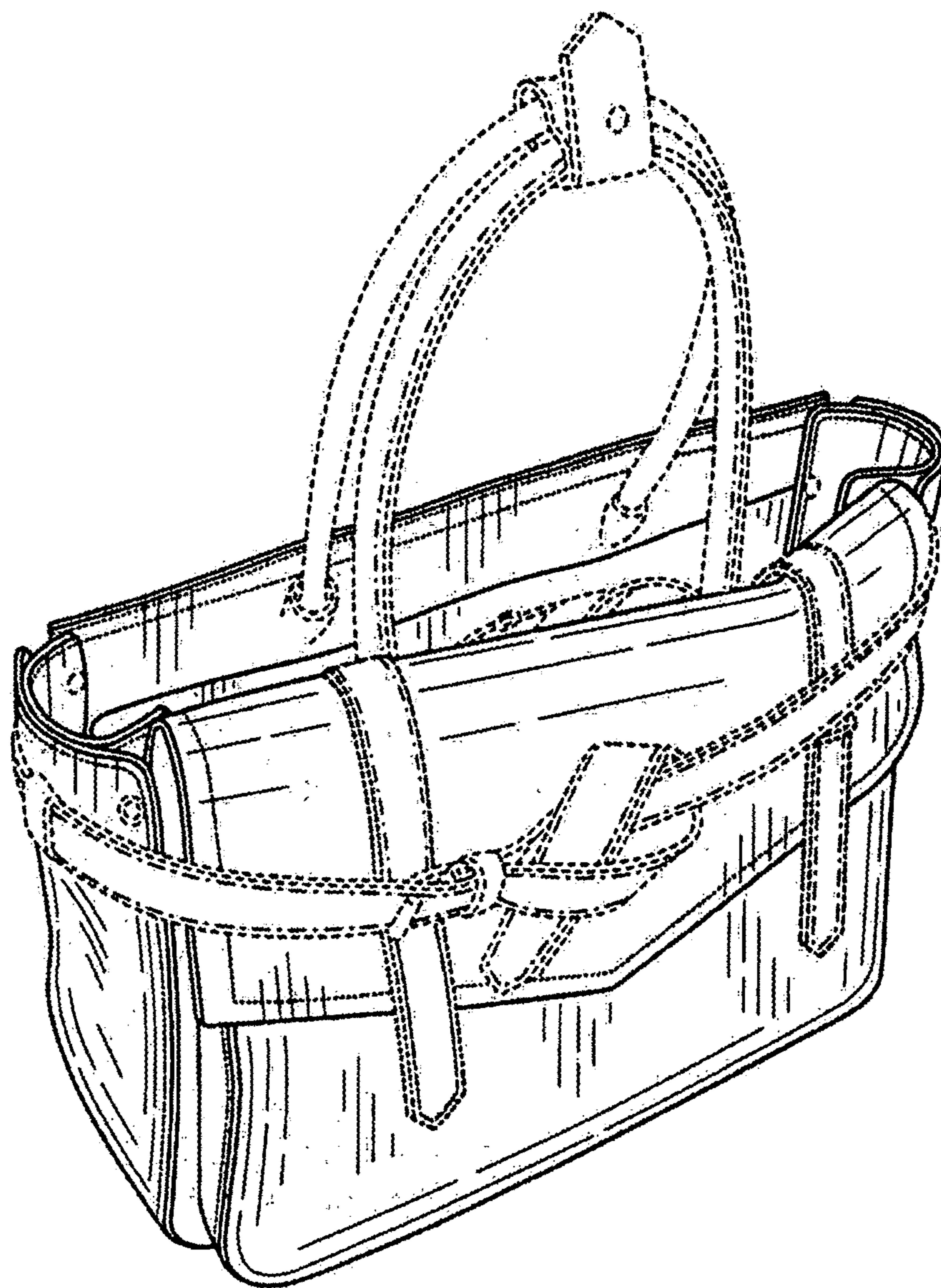

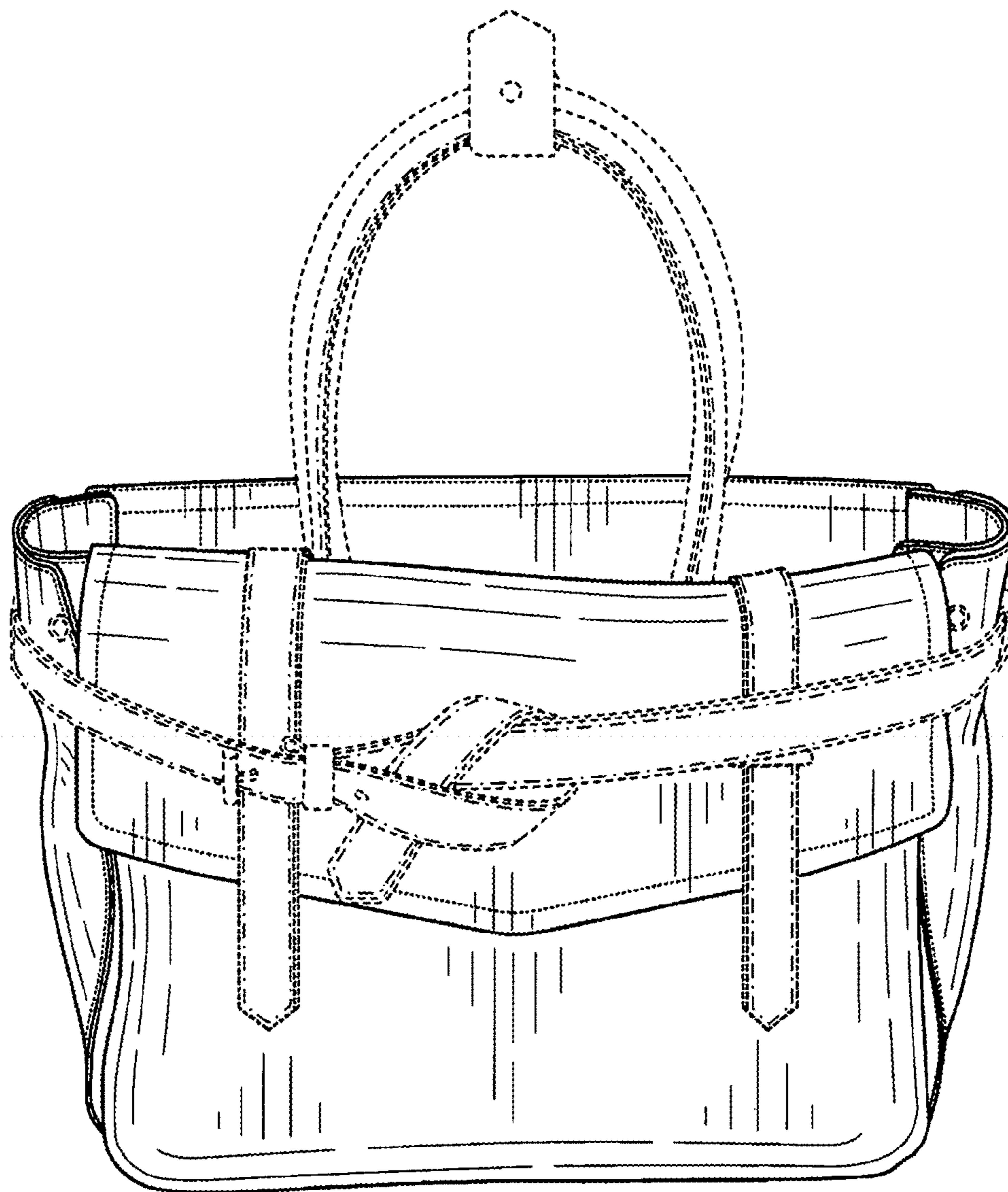

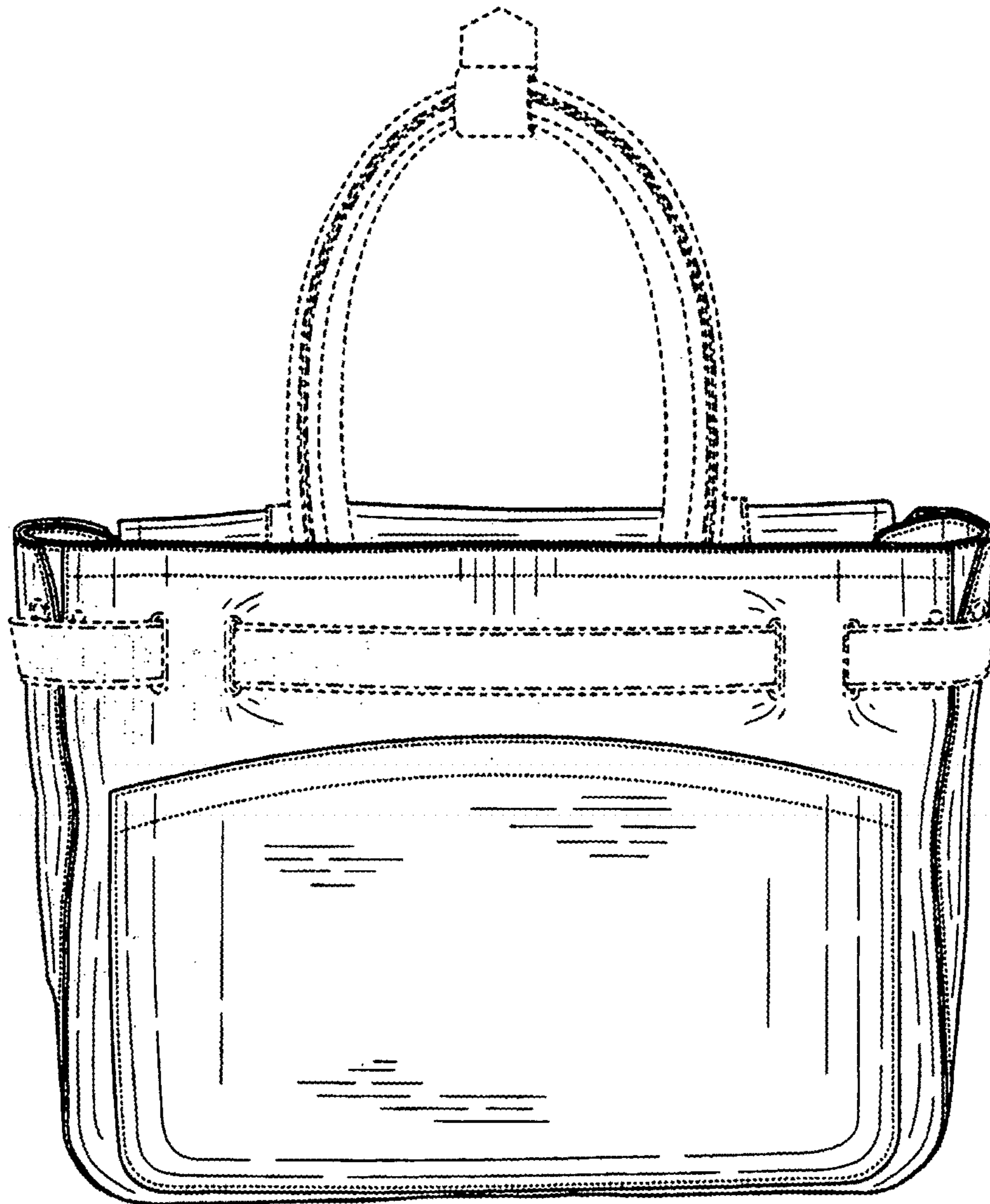

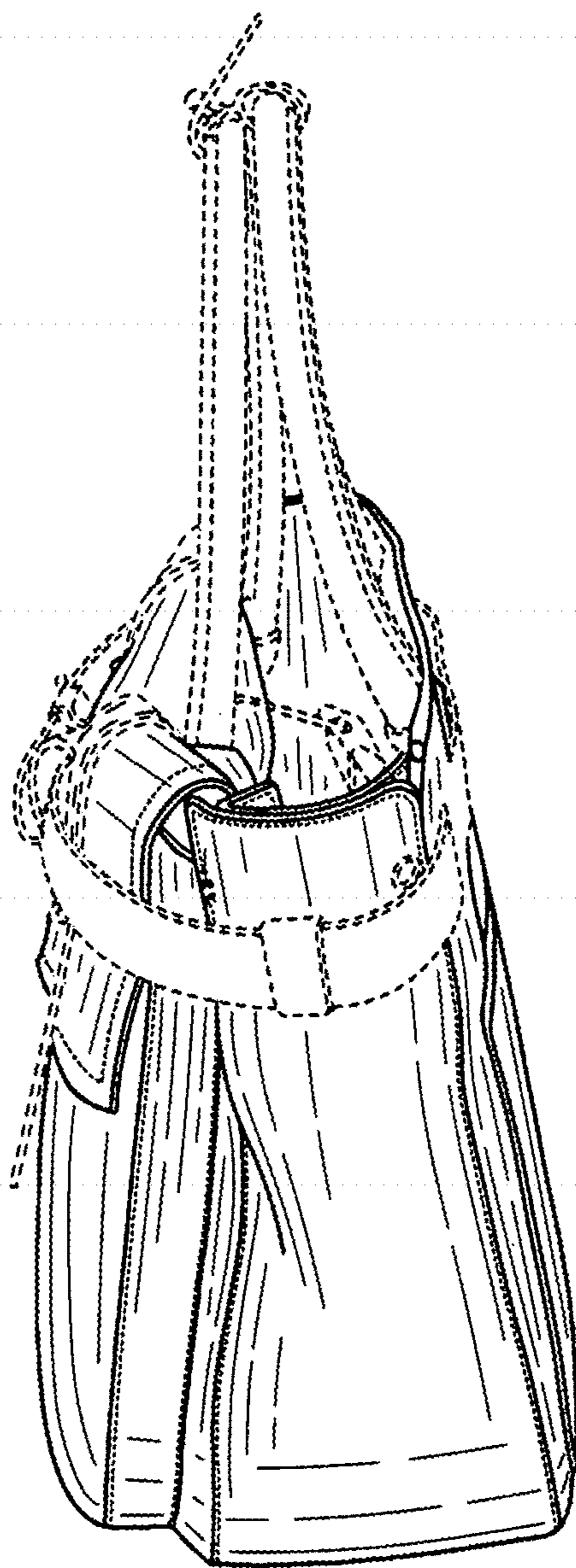

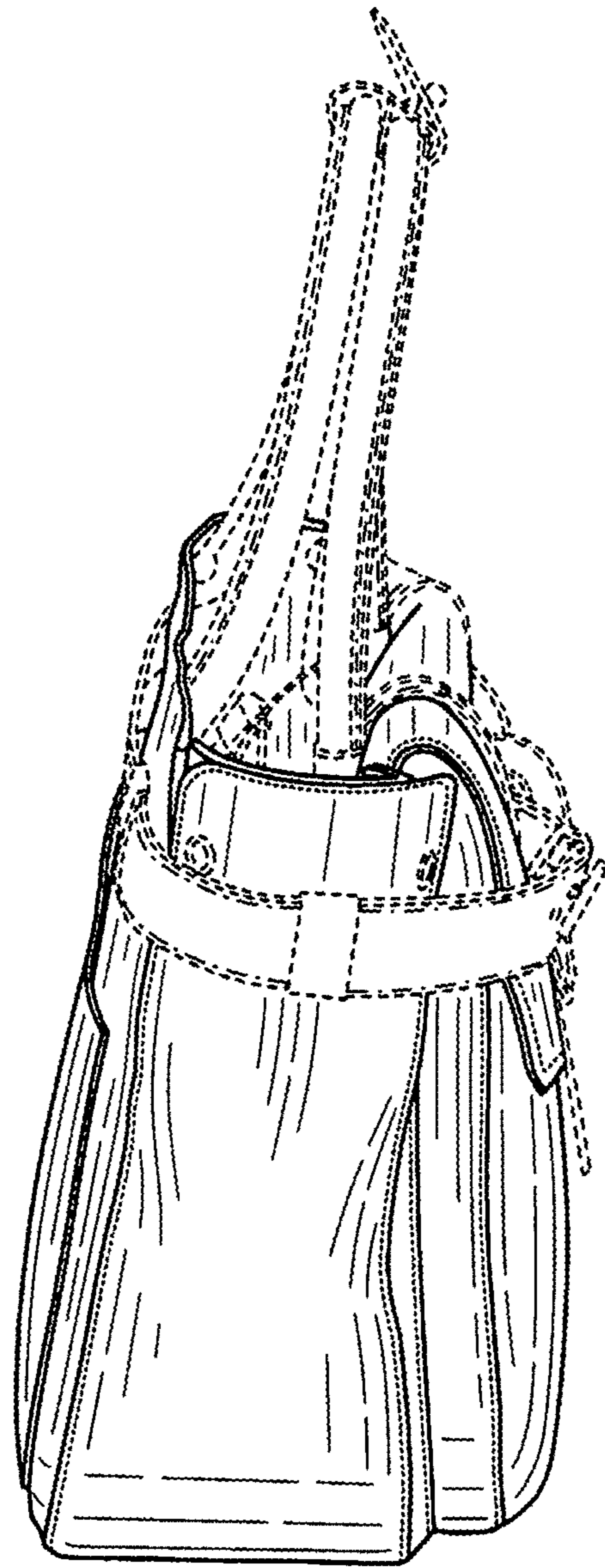

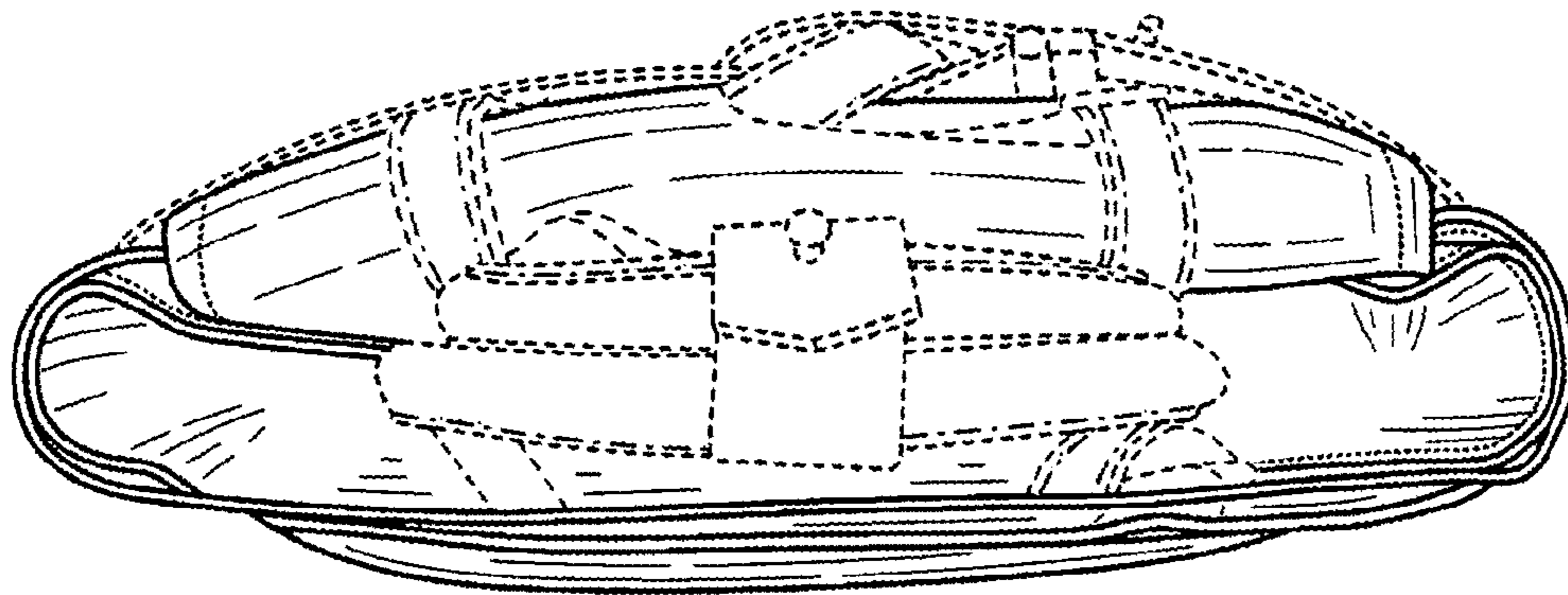

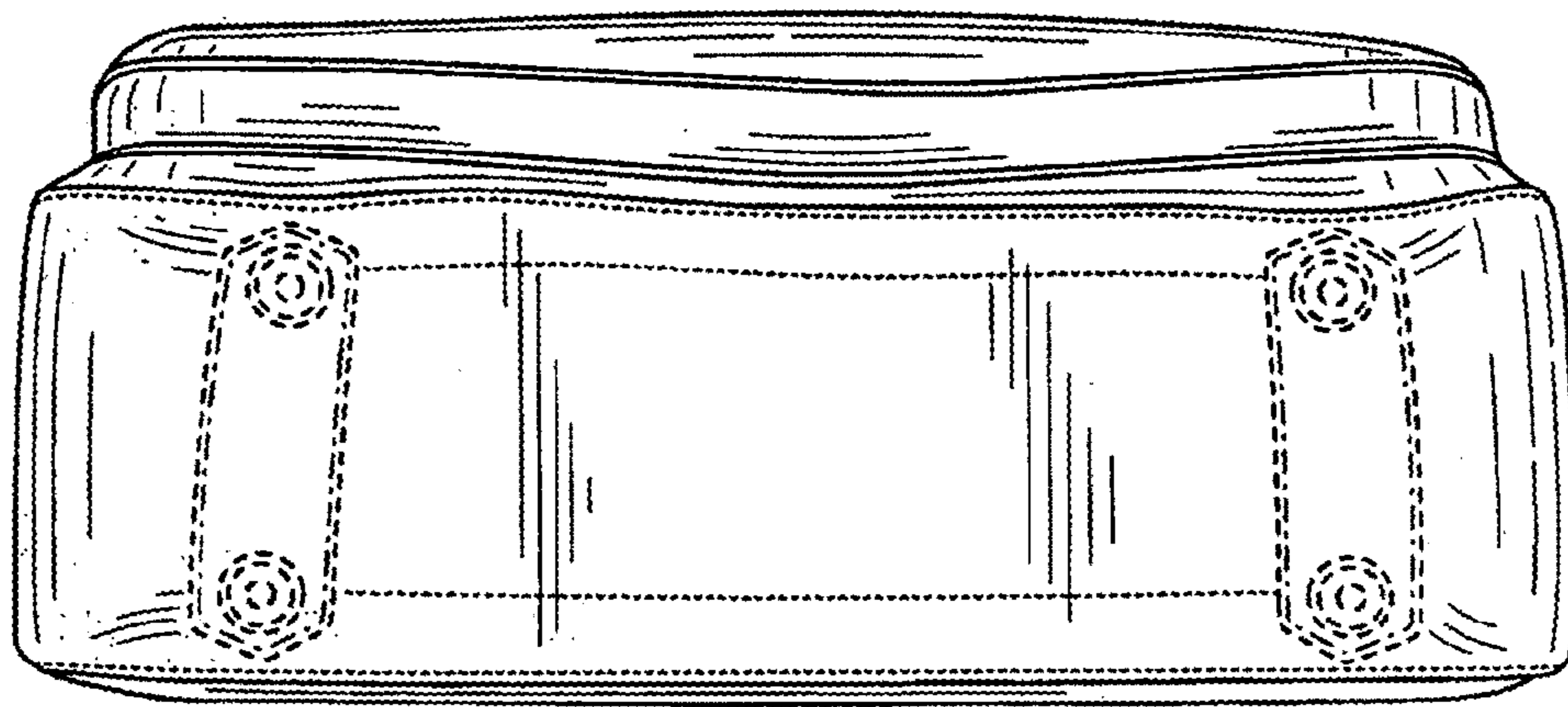
