FIG. 6 is a bottom planar view of FIG. 1.

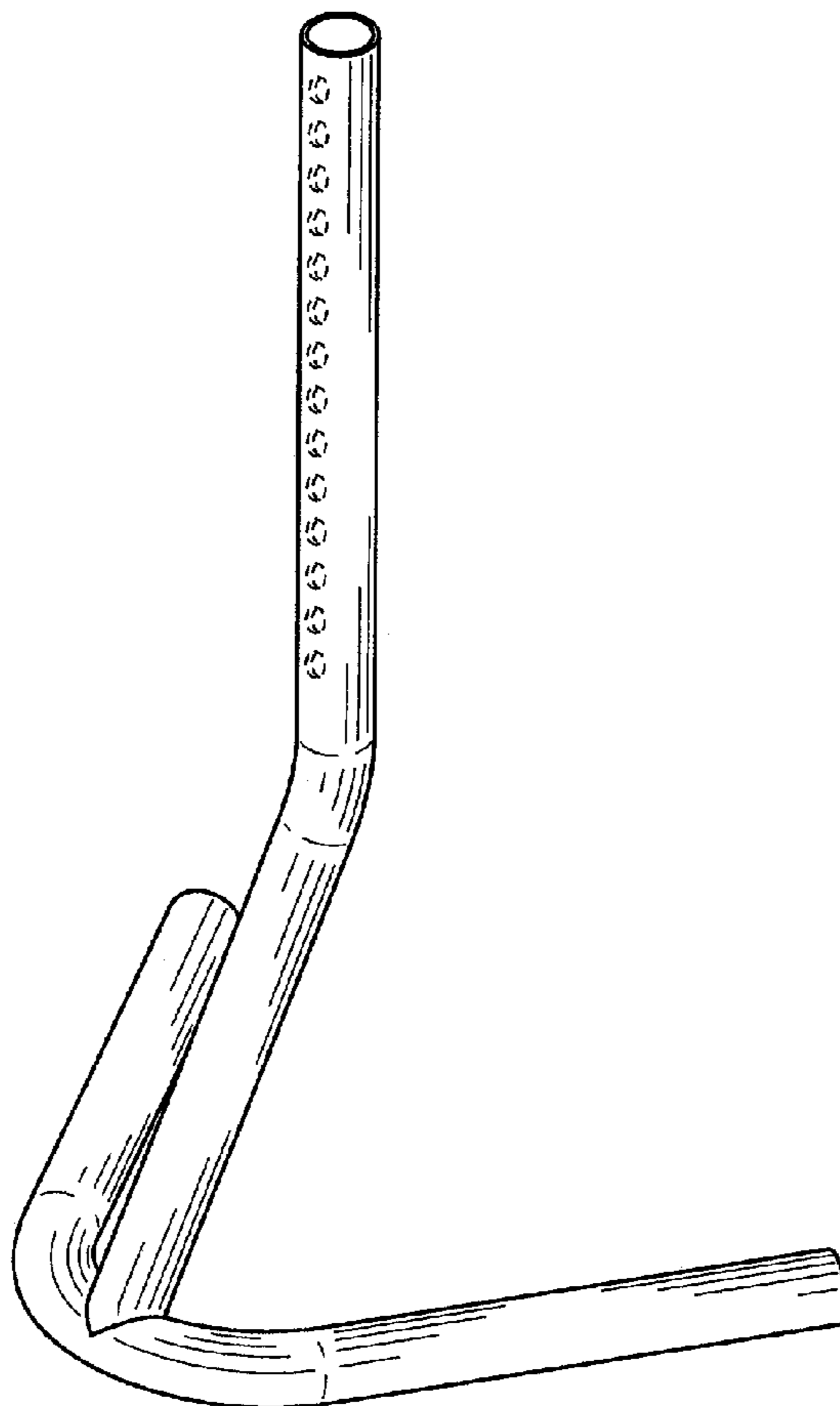

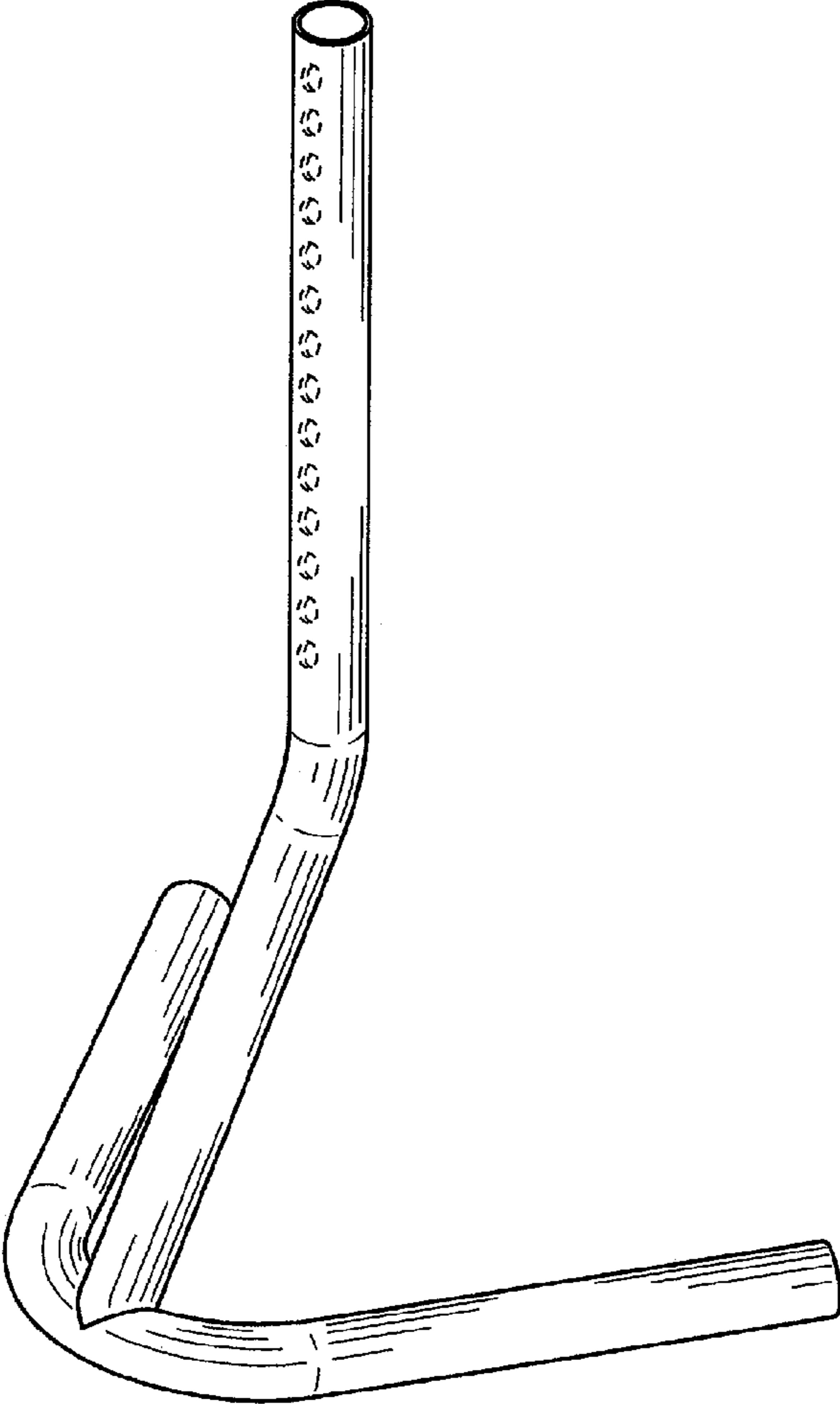

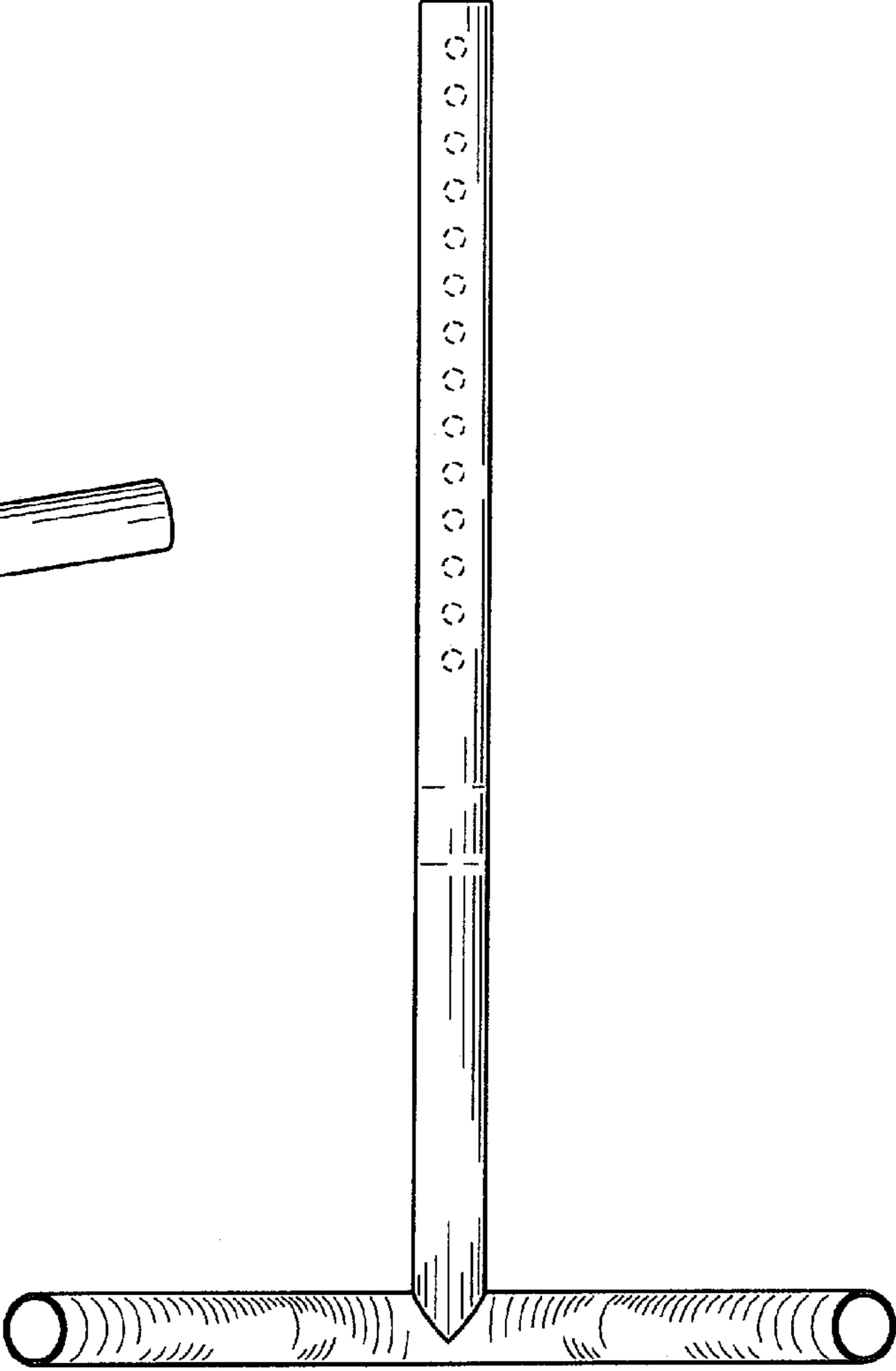

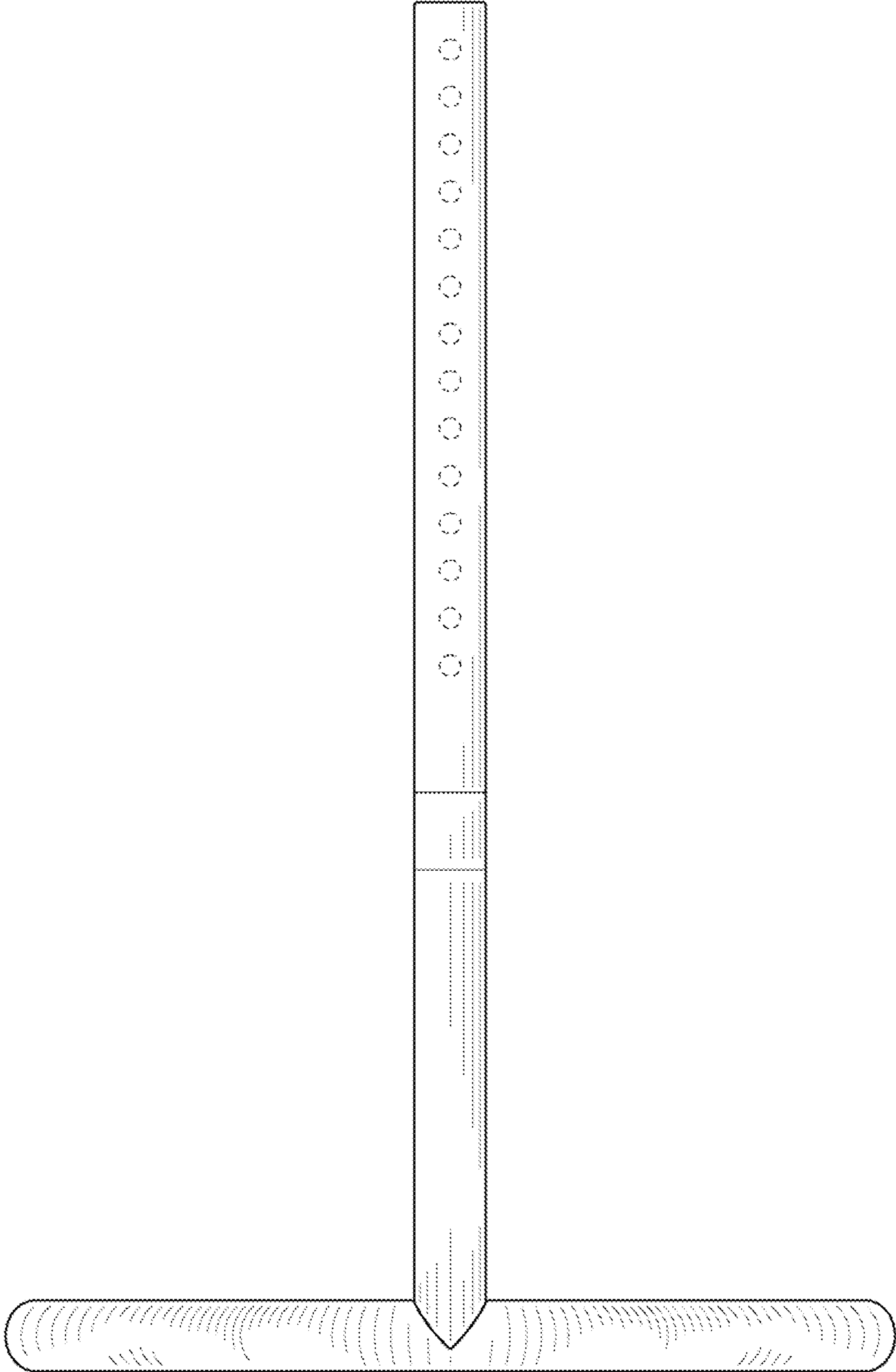

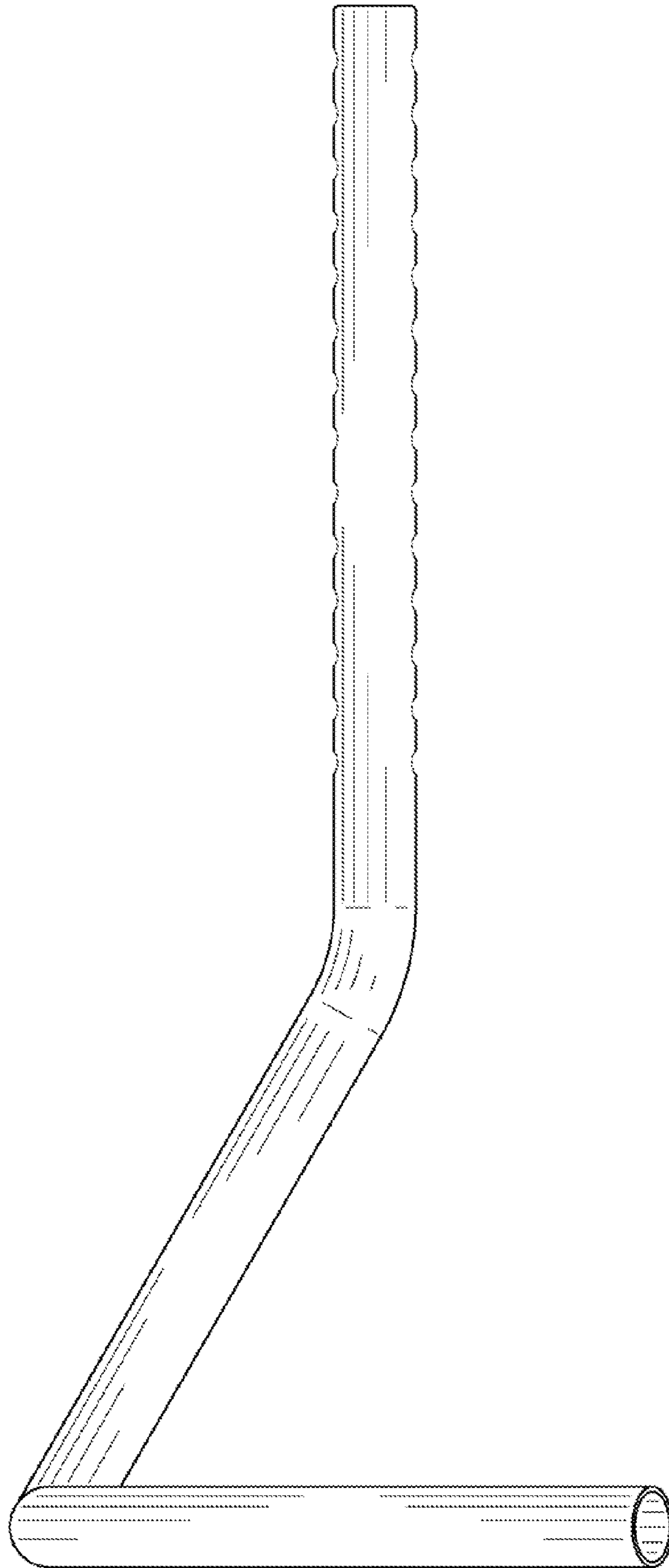

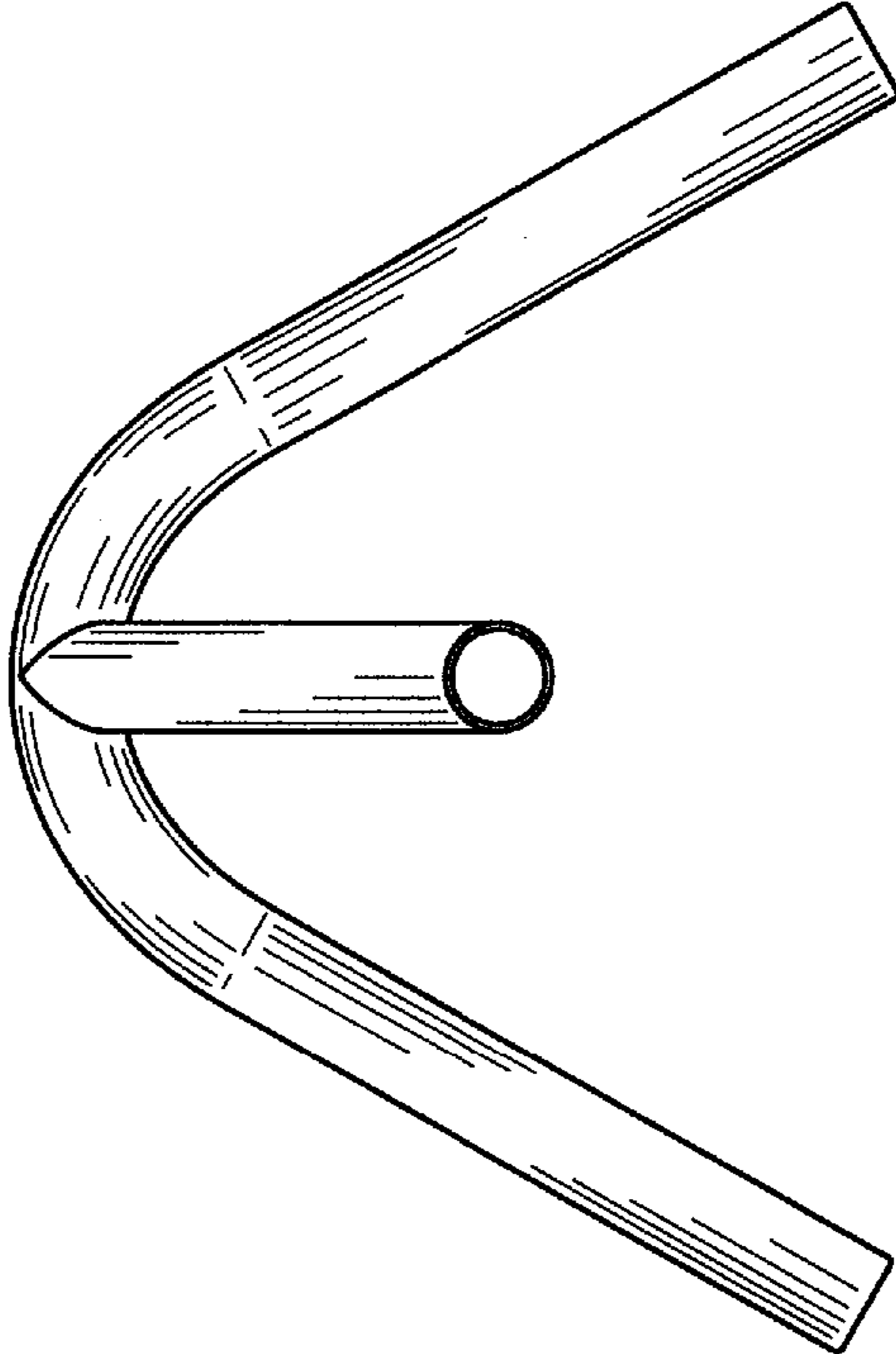

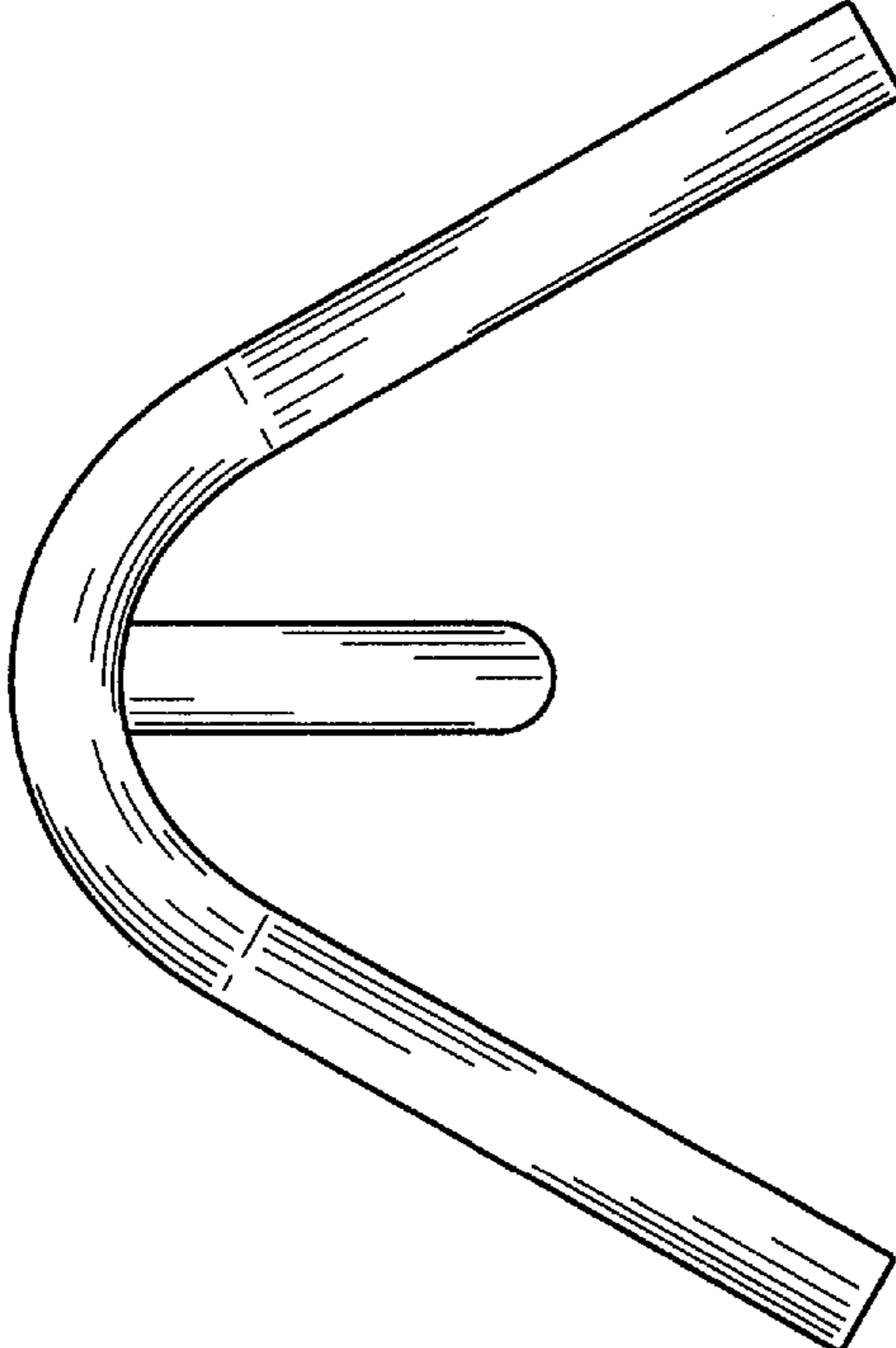
